

Multi-Color LED Flashlight Instructions:

Before using your flashlight for the first time:

- 1) Remove the battery from the flashlight by unscrewing the bottom end. Charge battery fully for the first time using the battery charger and USB cable. Once fully charged, the light on the charger will glow purplish blue. Re-insert battery by unscrewing the bottom of the flashlight. Make sure the + end is facing the power button. Screw the back end on tightly.

(Note: To help extend battery life, do not let the battery die completely before recharging. Standard battery life after each full charge will be approximately 8-10 hours of continuous use. Charging time can vary depending on how tired the battery is. Full charge of a completely dead battery will take approximately 2 hours.)

- 2) Do a test to make sure you aren't in Lock Mode. Try turning the flashlight on by pressing the power button once. If nothing happens, that means you might be in Lock Mode. To get out of Lock Mode, click the button rapidly until it starts flashing green. Then turn the flashlight off. You are now ready to access the 35 built-in colors. If you're not in Lock Mode, press and hold for 1 sec to turn flashlight off.

To access the 35 built-in colors:

- 1) Start with flashlight off.
- 2) Hold down button until you see Light Blue (the first color shown), then release your grip.
- 3) Hold down button again. You will see Light Blue, and then the color will change to Light Pink. Release your grip quickly on Light Pink. Flashlight will start flashing Light Blue.
- 4) Short click to cycle through each of the 35 colors. If you miss a particular color and want to return to it, keep pressing button, as all of the colors will keep repeating themselves. (Colors will follow the numbers on the User Guide pamphlet's Color Chart.)
- 5) To turn flashlight off, hold down the button and once lights start to flash, release your grip. Repeat this step for two more times.
- 6) Hold down button for ½ sec to turn flashlight off.
